## *Boat Handling under Power*

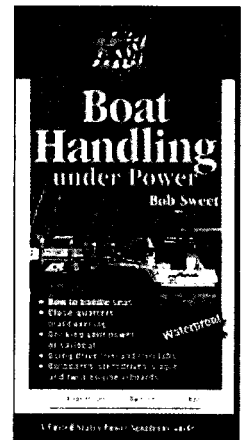
**Class Room:**
