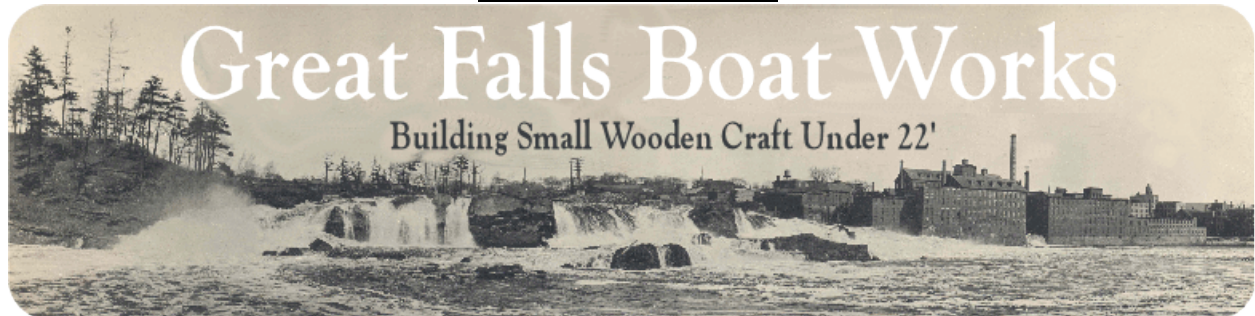

Directions to the Hotel:

From Portland International Jetport -

Exit the terminal and turn left onto Route 22. Continue on Route 22 until the intersection with Maine turnpike/Route 95. Take 95 north to exit 75. Turn left onto Route 202 and go approximately 4.5 miles into downtown auburn. Turn right onto Hampshire street and continue to the hotel.

From The South/Portland/Boston -

Take Route 95 north to exit 75. Turn left onto Route 202 and go approximately 4.5 miles into downtown Auburn. Turn right onto Hampshire Street and continue to the hotel.

From The North/Augusta/Bangor -

Take Route 95 south to exit 80/Lewiston. Take a right off the exit and go over the overpass. Take the second ramp on your right onto 196 west. Follow 196 west a few miles to the end. 196 is also called Lisbon Street. At the end of Lisbon Street, take a left onto Main Street and go over the bridge of the Androscoggin River. Take a right at the first light onto the Great Falls Plaza and continue to the hotel.
